Today, September 4, 2012, we started the meeting off by listening to a guest speaker, [Dr. Jackson P. Reiner](#), the department chair of Psychology and Counseling.

He told us about his professional life through several other universities. He began his career working with patients of AIDS through patients with chronic illnesses and is currently focusing on how to help a couple where one has organ transplants. He invited us to look through his publications including Crisis Counseling and Therapy and Rural Mental Health: Issues, Policies & Best Practices

He prides himself on being a Practicing Psychologist, as a Doctor in Counseling and a Diplomate in Clinical Psychology. He advocates young psychologists and “very good study” which he defines as

1. Going to classes
2. Using the benefits of advisors

Learning how to write well

3. Learning how to verbally present
4. Contributing to larger profession
5. Participating in the community
6. Stay curious

He went through the higher levels of education open to us including the Bachelor's, the Master's, and Doctoral program. He encourages us to ‘graduate from Valdosta State University curious,’ to get invested in the *study* of psychology, and to use our advisors who helped to found Georgia Psychological Society. He advises use to purchase and use Writing Papers in Psychology by Rosnow and Rosnow.
